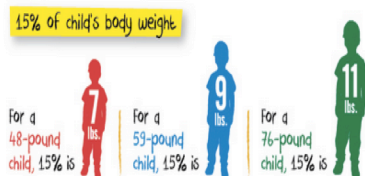

PCSD employs seven school nurses and three substitute nurses. We will continue to highlight one of our nurses each month. A note on Head lice...Head Lice do not originate in the schools, but because schools bring large numbers of children into close contact daily, the potential for the transmission of head lice exists. Direct head to head contact is necessary for transmission. Please check your child weekly for the presence of lice. Please notify the school if you find and treat lice on your child as we can be helpful in controlling the spread of head lice by providing educational assistance.
