In order to attend school, each student must provide proof of receiving appropriate immunizations. Students WILL NOT be permitted to attend school without receiving ALL the required vaccines for their age group, or being on schedule to complete an in-progress series.

It is your responsibility to have your child immunized and to provide the school with a medically verified, date- and dose- specific immunization record for all required immunizations he/she has received. This is required for school admission. Current requirements can be found [here](#).
